October 19, 2017

X Technical Counselor, Tom McMahon, gave a talk on spark plugs.

- A. When reinstalling plugs, use new or annealed copper gaskets.
- B. Install plugs with approximately 35 ft. lbs. of torque.
- C. Use two wrenches to tighten the plug wires to the plugs.
- D. When installing the plugs, use anti-seize compound.
- E. Keep plugs in order by placing them in a plug rack so that they can be rotated in the proper sequence.
- F. If a plug is dropped, replace it.
- G. Clean both ends of the plug.
- H. Gap the plugs according to specifications.

XI Sanford Reims gave a report on carbon monoxide. He and his wife, Diane, came very close to death from this gas poisoning. He advised everyone to have a carbon monoxide detector in their airplane.

XII Steve Berreman won the raffle with winning ticket number 471225. He received \$31.00.

XIII The meeting was adjourned.

XIV The program for the evening was delivered by Scott Franz. His program was entitled "Drones." He talked about drone avionics, control, capabilities, limitations, regulations, and future applications. He also mentioned the interface of drones with the general and flying public.
